LANGUEDOC, FRANCE, 2018

A fresh, fruity, elegant white with gentle citrus and flower flavours from the South.

2 PINOT GRIGIO LUNARDI £3.55 / £4.95 / £7.10 / £21.50
VENETO, ITALY, 2019

Delicious, squeaky-clean, peachy delight. Excellent version that shines out amongst it's bland bretheren. Lively & lovely.

3 MURPHY'S UNOAKED CHARDONNAY £3.75 / £4.95 / £7.50 / £22.50
MURRAY RIVER, AUSTRALIA, 2019

Brilliant wine. Light in touch. Dry, delicate, but satisfying. Anthony Murphy is winemaker and Patrick (his brother) grows the grapes in this family business.

4 RIOJA VEGA BLANCO £22.50
Rioja, Spain

Extremely tasty unoaked version from one of the oldest wineries (1882). Made from fruity Viura and rare Tempranillo Blanco grapes.

5 NIKA TIKI SAUVIGNON BLANC £25.90
Marlborough, New Zealand, 2020

Bursting with lemon and tropical fruit flavours, this refreshing New Zealand Sauvignon makes a perfect aperitif or paired with white fish & meat.

6 ECHEVERRIA SAUVIGNON BLANC (1/2 BOTTLE) £12.95
Molina, Chile, 2018

Light, fresh & youthful style.

MALMESBURY, SOUTH AFRICA

Deep ruby red in colour with hints of ripe red fruit, crushed black pepper, dried rose petals and candied cherries.

Like a "super-soft, Claret-style red" laden with plums, damsons and cherries.

9 MURPHY'S SHIRAZ £3.55 / £4.95 / £7.10 / £21.50
MURRAY RIVER, AUSTRALIA, 2018

Soft, smoky, fruity, mellow style of Shiraz. Peak quality fruit goes into this family-made wine.

9 SANTIAGO PINOT NOIR £3.70 / £4.90 / £7.45 / £22.35
CURICO VALLEY, CHILE, 2019

The lighter side of red, but the spicy, red berry character shines through & makes this excellent South American really appealing.

10 COTES DU RHONE GIVELIERE £23.00
Southern Rhone, France, 2018

Medium/Full bodied red from a big Chateaneuf producer. Mostly Grenache, some Syrah, giving warmth of fruit & spice

11 CHACABUCO MALBEC £25.00
Mendoza, Argentina, 2019

Plum, damson & black cherries, smooth & soft with ripe dark berry fruit and warm spice. High-altitude, long ripened Malbec fruit just tates right.

12 ECHEVERRIA MERLOT (1/2 BOTTLE) £12.95
Molina Valley, Chile, 2018

A mellow Merlot with good red fruit character.
