# IMPORTANT TO KNOW

## Is this calendar current?

Yes! This calendar is accurate at the time of printing (see cover page). While we strive to provide timely notification of scheduling changes, the most up-to-date information can always be found on the Members Portal event calendar.

## Can I bring guests to members only events?

You are most welcome to bring guests along with you! You will be required to book their places for them, and please ensure that you supply their names and email addresses when you book. The one exception is the Club AGM, which is only open to active Club Members.

## How do I book tickets to an event?

**Option 1:** Book online (recommended for faster booking)

The quickest and easiest way to secure your spot is by booking directly through our website or member portal.

1. Log in first! This is crucial, especially for member-only events. If you're having trouble seeing certain events or accessing tickets, it's likely you're not logged in.
2. Once logged in, you can click on one of the common search terms or simply scroll to the event you wish to attend and click the "Book Tickets" button.

**Option 2:** Email our membership secretary (Allow up to 48hr response time)

1. In your email, please clearly state the name, date and number of tickets for the event you wish to attend and if you would like to book in to the dining room for a pre/post event meal.
2. If you plan to bring any guests, please supply their full names and email addresses. We will then contact you directly regarding payment.

**Please note:** Our membership inbox receives a high volume of enquiries. If you have a short time limit for your booking, we strongly recommend using the online booking option as email responses may take a couple of days.
